#### Objectives and Goals:

- To promote the sport of swimming.
- To promote a healthy lifestyle.
- To determine the best athletes of the competition.
- To integrate athletes with disabilities.

#### Organizers:

The competition is organized by the Kaunas Swimming Masters and Disabled Club "Takas"

#### Date and Venue:

The competition will take place on September 13, 2025 (Saturday), at Fabijoniškės 25m Swimming Pool, Vėtrungių St. 45A, Vilnius (Fabijoniškės district).

The competition will be held in a 25-meter, 8-lane swimming pool equipped with an electronic timing system.

#### Competition Program

- 50 m Freestyle (Women and Men)
- 50 m Breaststroke (Women and Men)
- 50 m Backstroke (Women and Men)
- 50 m Butterfly (Women and Men)
- 100 m Individual Medley (Women and Men)

## Participants

Lithuanian and foreign swimmers aged 25 and over are invited to participate in the competition, with the exception of Russian and Belarusian athletes who do not have permanent residence permit in the Republic of Lithuania.

Disabled swimmers are also invited to participate. The list of disabled swimmers is limited to two heats.

Participants are personally responsible for their health and safety during the competition and confirm this by signing the protocol by registering

Age groups are determined according to World Aquatics Masters competition rules 25–29, 30–34, 35–39, 40–44, 45–49, 50–54, 55–59 ir t. t.

## Applications

Applications should be submitted until 4 September 2025.

Applications are submitted according to the attached form, indicating the personal best (or planned) result.

Registration is suspended when **100 participants are reached!**
